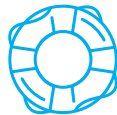

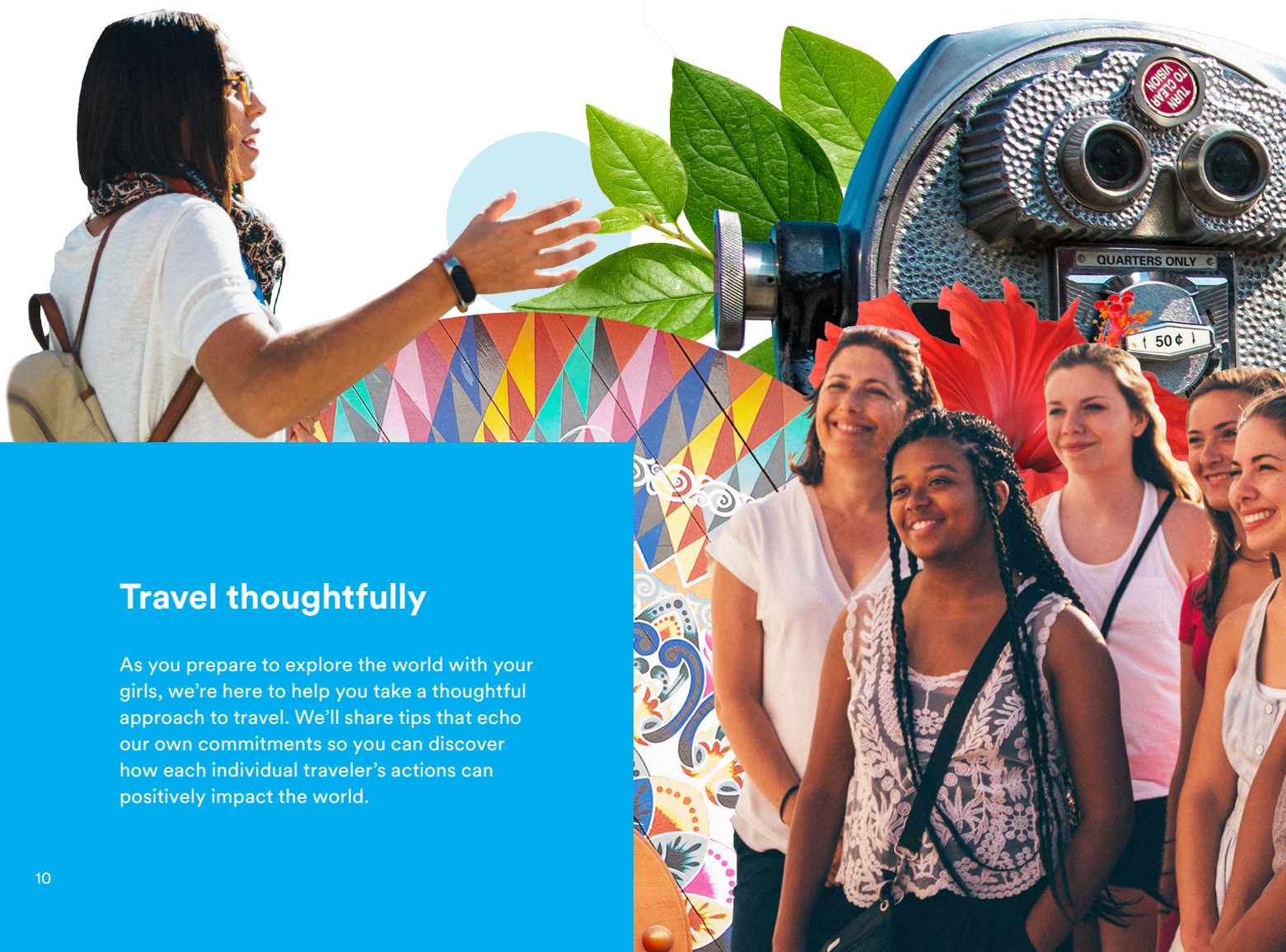


Always-on support

Protect the environment

We're constantly improving the sustainability of our tours. EF is committed to embracing eco-friendly approaches, supporting local conservation efforts, and reducing and recycling waste. We also recently announced a program to become carbon negative moving forward and become historically carbon neutral, removing all the carbon we've emitted since our founding in 1965. The first step toward our Hello Zero vision is the EF Forest Initiative, a project to create and conserve forests around the world. We're partnering with Eden Reforestation Projects to plant 3 million native-species mangrove trees in Kenya, Madagascar, and Mozambique.

Through our proud partnership with World Animal Protection, all our programs worldwide implement animal welfare best practices. On tour, you will discover the importance of animal welfare, learn to identify inhumane tourist attractions, and develop an understanding of the impacts of poaching and illegal wildlife products.

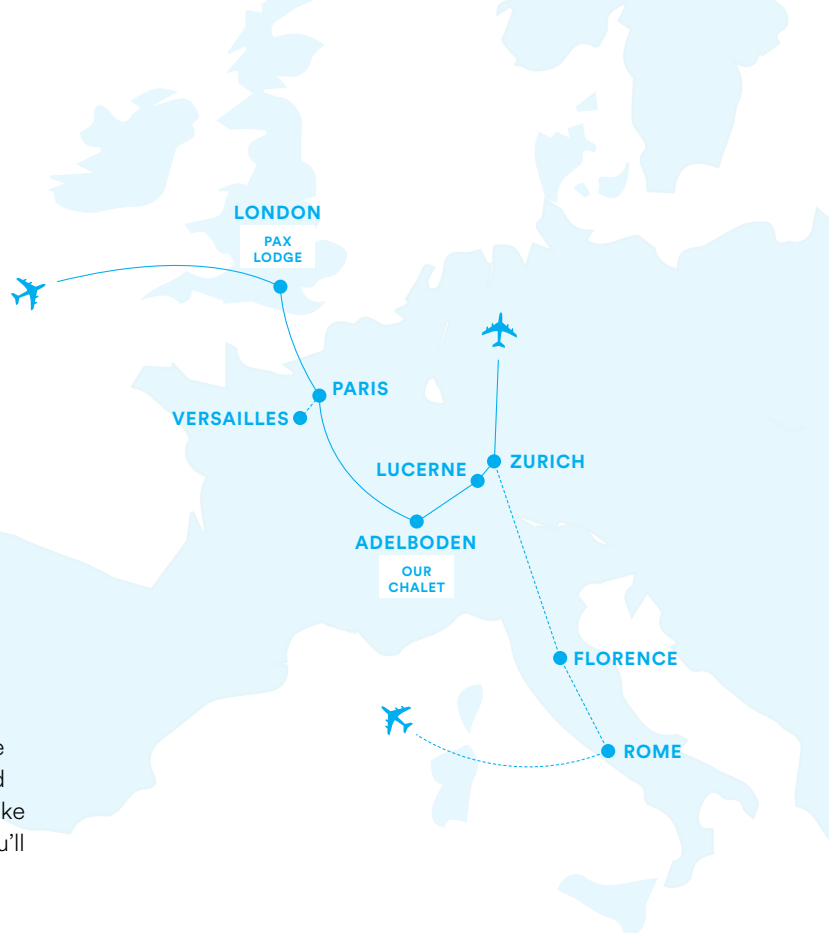


London to Lucerne

Celebrate sisterhood as you venture through the bustling streets of London, the museums of Paris, and the villages of the Swiss Alps together. Plus, you'll make special visits to Our Chalet and Pax Lodge, where you'll have the opportunity to make worldwide friendships and participate in empowering activities. Looking to add a fourth country to this amazing trip? Extend your tour to Italy to see the very best of Florence and Rome, and bond over some delicious gelato!



Days 1–2

London

Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London. Then, get to know the city on a walking tour. You'll head down the Strand to Trafalgar Square, the heart of the city, then continue to Covent Garden.

Days 3–4

London

Get ready for an experience you'll never forget when you visit Pax Lodge World Centre in the North London area of Hampstead. While there, you'll share in the sisterhood, participate in a pinning ceremony, and experience unique Girl Scout programming. Later, you'll take in the views from the top of the London Eye and enjoy a Thames River cruise. Finally, you'll travel with an expert local guide to see Big Ben and the Houses of Parliament, experience the electric atmosphere of Piccadilly Circus, and marvel at Westminster Abbey and Buckingham Palace.

Adventure in Peru

Embrace the spirit of Peru as your group explores the third-largest country in South America. Soak up ancient history on a visit to Machu Picchu and visit the mountain-nestled city of Cuzco. Spend two days greatly expanding your worldview in the Sacred Valley by working in a local community on projects that support economic sustainability, local agriculture, and access to education. Along your whole journey, you'll learn about the lives and responsibilities of Peruvian women, discovering how integral their skills and crafts are to the fabric of their communities. Your adventure will be capped off by two incredible days at an Amazon lodge, where you'll explore the flora and fauna of the jungle both on foot and by boat.

Days 1–2

Lima

Meet your Tour Director at the airport in Lima. Later, get to know your surroundings while on an expert led tour. You'll see vestiges of the city's rich colonial heritage, including the Government Palace and the Lima Cathedral. You'll also visit the 17th century San Francisco Monastery as well as the Larco Museum, which features the finest gold and silver collection from ancient Peru. You'll wrap up your second day with a walking tour of Miraflores, one of Lima's most affluent areas.

Day 3

Lima | Cuzco

Fly to Cuzco, the "navel of the Earth" and the former epicenter of a vast empire stretching from Colombia to Chile. Here you can explore the Korkancha Temple, scene of Incan religious rites in bygone times. At the Sacsayhuaman fortress, witness a feat of masonry that confounds modern scientists; its irregularly shaped stones are pieced together so precisely that even a piece of paper cannot be wedged between them. Your expert local guide will also point out the magnificent Cuzco Cathedral.

Days 4–5

Cuzco | Sacred Valley

Travel to the Sacred Valley, where you'll explore a community, build relationships with locals, and bond with your group through a service project. As communities evolve, so do their needs. That's why EF works closely with local nonprofits to better understand each community's issues in order to develop unique projects. Throughout your stay, you'll be immersed in cultural activities, celebrate local customs and traditions, and meet lots of new people and hear their stories.



Days 6–7

Machu Picchu | Cuzco

Tour Machu Picchu with an expert local guide. See remnants of temples and terraces that have yet to reveal the true purpose of Machu Picchu—some believe only an elite Incan priesthood knew of its existence. Afterward, travel to Cuzco, where you'll have time to explore on your own before visiting a local community.

Days 8–9

Cuzco | Iquitos | Amazon lodge

Fly to Iquitos, then travel by boat to an Amazon lodge. Remember to keep a lookout for some of the Amazon River's most unique wildlife, including piranha and pink river dolphins.

Days 10–11

Lima | Return home

Fly to Lima before boarding your overnight flight home.

Travel through sacred shrines, see the Great Buddha in Kamakura, and catch a glimpse of majestic Mount Fuji. Engross yourself in the buzzing technology and shopping hub of Akihabara. Expand your palates together by bonding over delicious new foods, including an authentic tempura dinner, and enjoy a special overnight stay at a traditional Japanese *ryokan*.

Days 1–4

Tokyo

Meet your Tour Director at the airport and dive into the world's biggest city on an expert-led tour of the Ginza District, Imperial Palace, and more. Visit the Meiji Shinto Shrine and the Harajuku shopping district, where young denizens blaze a path for fashion-lovers everywhere. Explore the seventh-century Asakusa Kannon Temple before taking a sightseeing tour through the technology district of Akihabara Electric Town. Try new foods together as you enjoy a sumo-style hot pot dinner and learn more about the age-old Japanese art of sumo. Later on, enjoy a full free day to explore Tokyo on your own, or take an excursion to Tokyo Disney Resort.

Day 5

Tokyo | Kamakura | Hakone

Travel to Kamakura and take a moment to reflect at the Hachimangu Shrine and Great Buddha statue. Continue on to Hakone for spectacular views of Mount Fuji. Enjoy the simplicity of your surroundings and sleep on a futon atop tatami-matted floors—just remember to remove your shoes before entering.

Day 6

Hakone | Odawara | Kyoto

See volcanic sulfur springs in Owakudani, enjoy a boat cruise on the sparkling Lake Hakone, and take a cable car ride up Mount Komagatake. Put history in context with a photo stop at Odawara Castle, which has survived five centuries of war, politics, and earthquakes. Then ride the Shinkansen bullet train to Kyoto, a city that conjures up images of sunlit walks around tiered pagodas and quiet lakes lined with cherry blossom trees.



Days 7–8

Kyoto | Nara | Osaka

From the bamboo trees of Arashiyama to the tranquil Golden Pavilion, get to know Kyoto with your expert local guide. As the national capital for over a millennium, Kyoto offers you a unique glimpse into the history of Imperial Japan. Next, discover more about traditional Japanese fashion during a kimono show at the Nishijin Textile Center, and compare this experience to the clothing you saw in the ultramodern Harajuku district. Visit the Fushimi Inari Shrine, as well as the ancient capital of Nara, followed by a walking tour of Osaka's colorful Dotonbori canal street.

Days 9–11

Return home or add more tour

Depart for home on Day 9 or witness the effects of World War II from a Japanese perspective during an enlightening visit to the Peace Memorial Museum in Hiroshima. Later on, visit Itsukushima Shrine on Miyajima Island, Himeji Castle, and more.

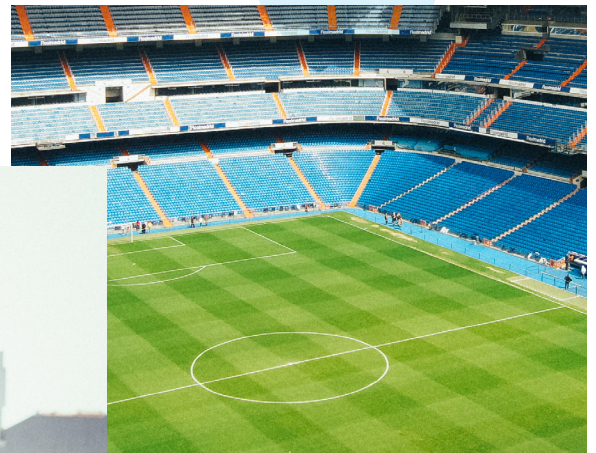
Special Interest tours

Days 1–2

Barcelona

Welcome to Barcelona! Explore this art- and soccer-lover's dream city with your Tour Director, and see Gaudí masterpieces, the Gothic Quarter, and the Mediterranean boardwalk.

Days 3–4

Barcelona

See La Sagrada Família—an unmistakable symbol of Barcelona—and Park Güell, known for its bright mosaic lizard fountain. Then soak in beautiful views of the harbor from atop Montjuïc. Tour Camp Nou Football Stadium and the F.C. Barcelona Museum. After a bike tour of the city, sharpen your skills in a soccer clinic.

Days 5–6

Barcelona | Madrid

Travel to Madrid, home to Real Madrid CF, one of the world's most famous soccer teams. Take a walking tour of the city, enjoy a panoramic bus tour, and wander the extravagant hallways of Palacio Real. Then participate in another soccer clinic or visit Santiago Bernabeu Football Stadium. End your day with a traditional Flamenco evening.

Days 7–8

Madrid | Return home

Participate in a soccer-themed immersion activity with the Third Half organization, whose mission is to improve the lives of boys and girls in underserved communities around the world. Dragones de Lavapies, a nonprofit, multicultural, grassroots soccer club, will host this event. End your trip by taking a mouth-watering Spanish cooking class.

Days 1–2

London

Meet your Tour Director at the airport in London.
