Explore two of the most beautiful Mediterranean countries with other like-minded educators. Visit the ancient city of Rome to see it a bit differently than you would on your student tour. Later, jet off to Malta's picturesque capital, Valletta.

Day 1 |

Sit back and relax aboard your overnight flight to Italy.

Day 2 | D

Touch down in Rome where you will be greeted by your Tour Director and EF Staff. They'll help you transfer to the hotel to drop off your bags. If time allows, enjoy some free time in the historic capital city of Rome while the rest of the group arrives. This evening, be our guest at a special welcome dinner. Enjoy fine food and conversation as you become acquainted with other travelers and EF staff.








Day 3 | BD

Taste your way through the city on a guided food-focused walking tour. Stop at different venues in the iconic Monti neighborhood, one of the most bustling areas of the Eternal City. Then, enjoy some free time to explore the city as you'd like. In the evening, continue your culinary journey during a hands-on evening cooking class followed by dinner with the group.

Day 4 | BD

Start the day off with a morning seminar session led by EF staff. You'll hear company-wide updates and get the chance to talk about your experiences as a Group Leader in small groups. In the afternoon, head to Malta by plane. Once you arrive in the capital, Valletta, you'll enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Day 5 | B

Start your day with a guided sightseeing tour that will let you explore the city by bus *and* foot. Visit St. John's Co-Cathedral and St. George's Square, then enter the Grandmaster's Palace to experience astonishing works of art. Enjoy a break for lunch before continuing on to see the Rotunda of Mosta, the Lascaris War Rooms, and the breathtaking panoramic views from the Upper Barrakka Garden. Take the rest of the day to explore even more of Valletta.

Day 6 | BD

Venture out of Valletta for a day of guided sightseeing in Mdina and Tarxien. Head to Mdina for a walking tour of the old capital. Stop by St Paul's Square where you can visit St. Paul's Cathedral and Catacombs. See other famous ruins and museums as you explore more of Mdina. Then, continue on to the town of Tarxien where your guide will bring you through the Tarxien Temples, a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

Day 7 | B

Spend the day relaxing at a nearby beach. Marvel at the beautiful blue waves of the Mediterranean Sea, soak up the sun, or explore the town for some last-minute shopping.

Day 8 | BD

In the morning, you'll head back to Rome by plane. Enjoy some free time in the city, then join the rest of the group for a special farewell dinner.

Day 9 | B

Transfer to the Rome International Airport for your flight home.
